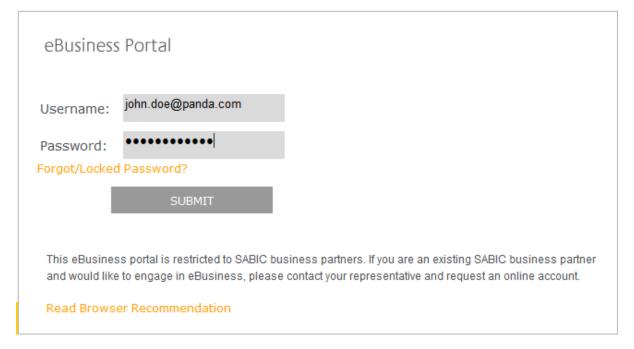




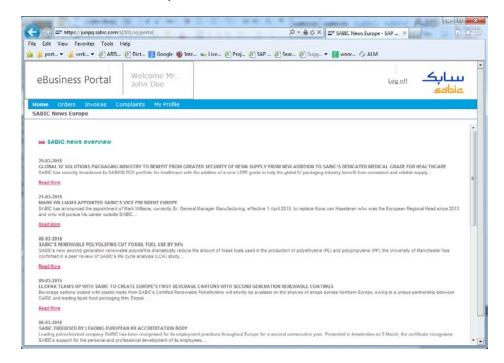
Create order in the eShop

To create an order in the shop you login to the shop using the account username and password supplied by your SABIC contact.

The URL for the SABIC web shop is: https://ebusiness.sabic.com/irj/portal



Click submit to enter the portal





You have two options to create an order:

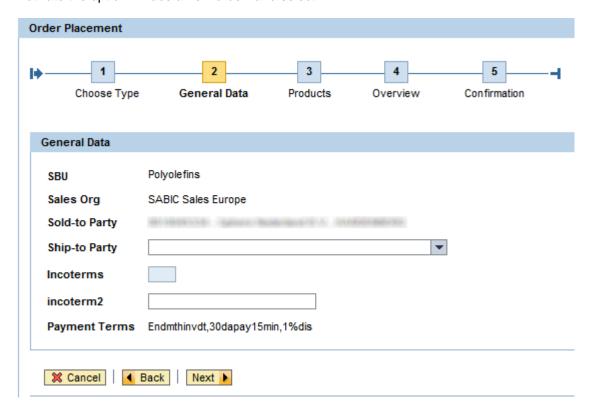
- 1. Create a new order by supplying all the details
- 2. Create a new order by copying from an already existing order

Create an order by supplying all the details

To create such an order:

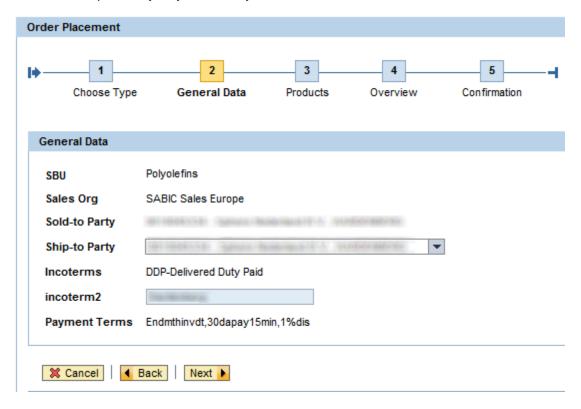
Click on the menu tab Orders and then New Order

Activate the option: "Place a new order" and select: Next .





Select the Ship-to Party as your delivery address:



The appropriate incoterms will be displayed automatically

Select Next to continue to the next screen

In the next screen you supply the:

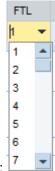
- Purchase Order reference;
- Products in the appropriate packaging;
- Number of FTL¹'s for that product / packaging;

The steps to order for instance 5 truckloads on several days are:

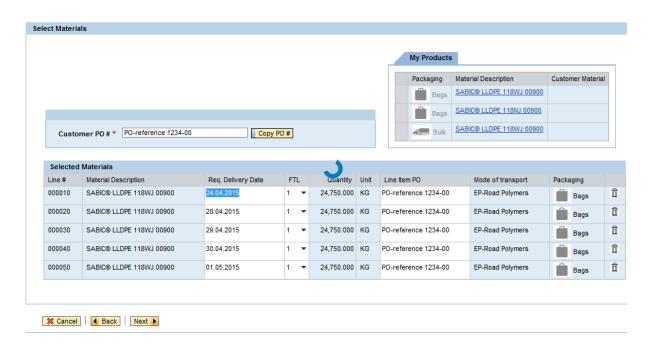
1. You select the material / packaging you want to order from the table "My Products". by clicking on the appropriate line you add the material to the order;

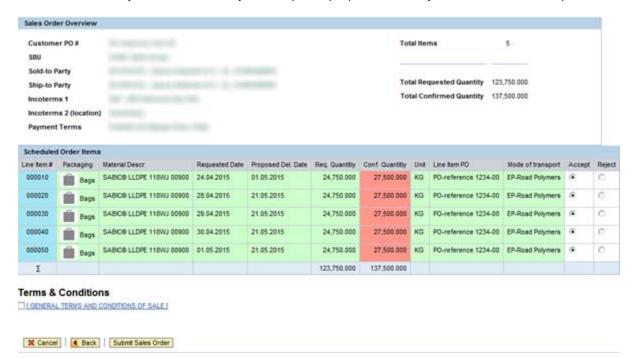
- 2. You select the number of FTL's by using the dropdown list for selection:
- 3. Use the button: Split to split the FTL's into separate line items with one FTL per line. During this operation it will also duplicate the noted requested delivery date;
- 4. Fill in the requested delivery dates per line item by clicking on the appropriate field. It comes up when you click on the "Req. Delivery Date" field;
- 5. By clicking on the button: Copy PO # you copy the Purchase number reference in the text field next to it to every line item. Later if required you can change the PO reference on every line item individually;
- 6. If needed you can remove lines items from the order by clicking the appropriate button:
- 7. If you want to add FTL's you can do so selecting the same material / packaging from the "My Products" list;
- 8. You can also add different materials / packaging to the order provided that all materials in the order come from the same plant. You can do so by selecting the material to be added in the "My Products" list. If you have questions about this please contact your SABIC contact.



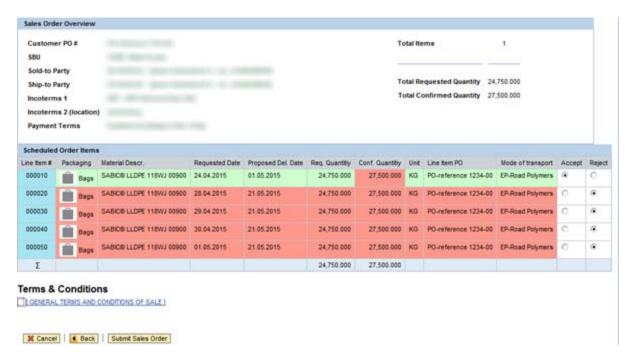


By clicking on the button: Next you go to the next page. For your materials/packaging the system calculates if we can meet the requested delivery dates. If not the system will propose an alternative date per order line. The system also calculates the rounded quantity for one FTL.

In the next screen you can indicate if you accept the proposed delivery date if different to requested.



If you reject the proposed date you still can save the order and you will be contacted by our sales staff to discuss alternatives.





Before placing the order you are requested to accept our General Terms and Conditions of Sale. You can do this by activating the appropriate check box: GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE 1

By clicking the button: Submit Sales Order you can submit you order to SABIC.

In the next screen you will see the SABIC sales Order number:



A print of the request is available on this page as well please do not regard this as an order confirmation as that will be communicated to you via regular channels.

Creating an order by copying from the old order

In the screen where you can select the order type you select the option: "Copy from Old". In the field:

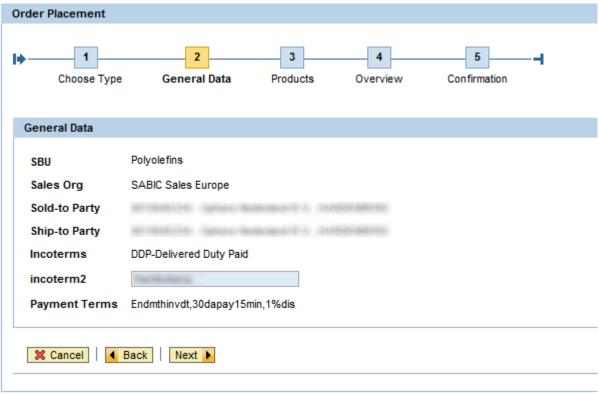
Please enter an old order # you enter the original order you want to copy the data from. By selecting you proceed to the next step.

In the meantime the system copies data from the order you've selected:

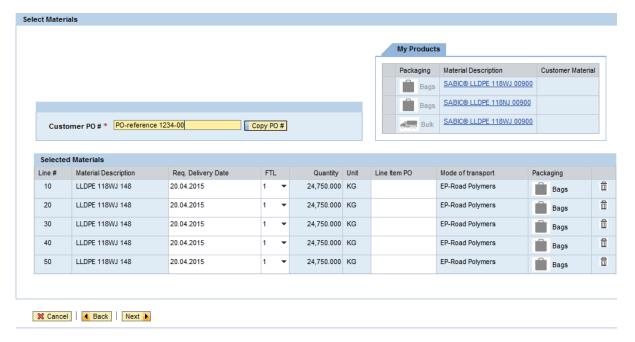
- Partners (sold to, ship to, payer, bill to)
- incoterms
- Materials / packaging
- Purchase Reference number on header level

In the next screen the system displays the general data of the order:





By selecting Next by you proceed to the next step:



From then on you can create the order as if you've entered all the appropriate data yourself. When later on submitting the order you create a new order in our system and you will be presented with the appropriate sales order number.

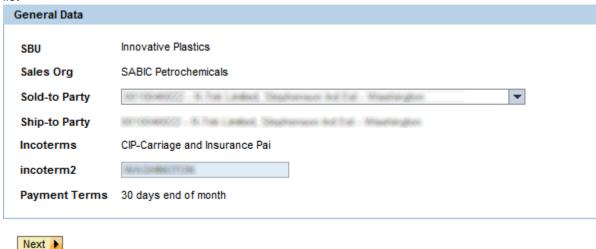


Create consignment order

In case you have a consignment arrangement with SABIC you can create a consignment fill up order in the eShop

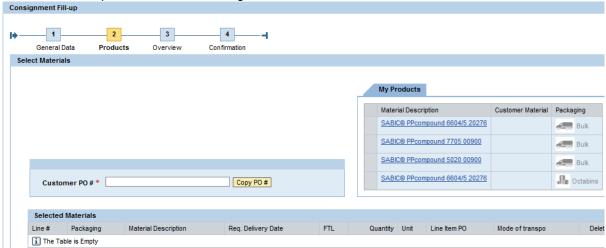

- If you're able to order for more than one sold to party you select the appropriate one in the 1st stage in the drop down list



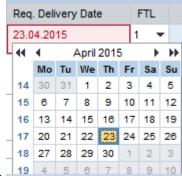


Click Next to proceed to the next stage



- Add the materials to your order by selecting it from the My Products list;
- Enter your PO reference number in the appropriate text box and copy it to line-items. You can also enter a PO reference number on individual line-items;



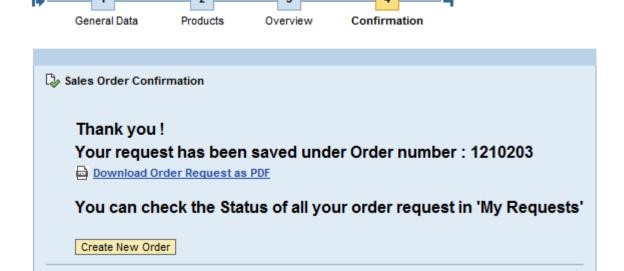


- Select a requested delivery date by entering it on line-item level:
- Proceed with Next to the next screen;
- In case the lead time cannot be met line item is reported in red and the system proposes an alternative. Please indicate if you accept or reject the proposal. If you reject you can still save the order and you will be contacted by our sales staff to arrange an alternative. To save the order please first accept the General Terms and Conditions of Sales by checking the appropriate box:
